Youth Advisory Council Policies, Procedures and Expectations:

- Attend all full YAC meetings listed on schedule by zoom, phone or in person.
- Attend all designated committee meetings as set by the committee on which you serve (at least once per month).
 - If you are not able to call-in or attend a full YAC meeting or your committee meeting you
 must contact your NYLC Staff Advisor and other YAC members before the meeting. You
 may be asked to complete some assigned responsibilities due to the missed call.
 - Any YAC member who misses 2 full YAC meetings within a 12-month period will be asked to reconsider their commitment to YAC. This will involve a conversation with the NYLC Staff Advisor.
 - YAC members who miss 3 unexcused full YAC meetings or Committee meetings within a 12-month period will be asked to resign from the YAC.

YAC Service-Learning Expectations

All YAC members will participate in facilitating leadership activities that include bringing young people together at events, addressing issues they are passionate about, planning and participating in national conferences, and supporting the work of the organization.

YAC Mid-year Review

All YAC members will undergo an initial goal setting plan and a mid-year evaluation with the NYLC Staff Advisor. The mid-year evaluation and what it entails will be shared during the Fall Retreat. The mid-year evaluation will take place both during year 1 and during year 2 of the YAC commitment.
